INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS PROCEDURES FOR KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION SEPTEMBER 2024

1. To register for **English Kindergarten** do so at your catchment school.

North Zone: Sidney, KELSET, Deep Cove

Central Zone: Keating, Brentwood

South Zone: Cordova Bay, Lochside, Prospect Lake

2. To register for the **French Immersion Kindergarten Lottery** do so at your Fl catchment school:

Keating Catchment Schools - Keating, Brentwood, Cordova Bay, Lochside, Prospect Lake Deep Cove School Catchment Schools - Sidney, KELSET, Deep Cove

3. To register at a school **outside of your catchment area**:

Go to your catchment school

Complete the District Registration Form and

Complete an "Out of catchment area application" form

Leave all registration forms at the catchment school

(every effort will be made to confirm placements by the end of June when possible, and by September 15th at the latest)

- 4. To **register siblings** of students who currently attend a Saanich Elementary School but live 'Out of Catchment', please register at the older child's school. *This only applies if the older sibling is still attending the elementary school when the youngest enters.
- 5. To complete the Registration process, you will **need to bring the following original documents:**

3 Proof of address documents (e.g., Purchase or Tenancy Agreement, Driver's License, Utility Bill) Child's Birth Certificate or valid Passport
